The Alabama Supreme Court, in Ex parte Killingsworth, [Ms. 1090589, December 30, 2010] ___ So. 3d ___ (Ala. 2010), reversed this Court's judgment and held that Killingsworth was denied his right to be tried by an impartial jury and that he
