We hereby suspend the provisions of Rule 39(g) and (h), Ala. R. App. P., allowing the petitioner and the respondent to file a brief and to request oral argument, and we summarily grant the writ. In <u>Ex parte Gunn</u>, [Ms. 1051754, September 21, 2007] \_\_\_\_ So. 2d \_\_\_\_ (Ala. 2007), this Court overruled <u>Wells</u> <u>v. State</u>, 941 So. 2d 1008 (Ala. Crim. App. 2005), to the extent that <u>Wells</u> created a limitation on a trial court's jurisdiction to consider successive motions filed pursuant to § 13A-5-9.1, Ala. Code 1975. The Court of Criminal Appeals in this case relied solely on <u>Wells</u> for its affirmance of the trial court's judgment. Therefore, we reverse the judgment of the Court of Criminal Appeals and remand the case for proceedings consistent with Gunn.

WRIT GRANTED; REVERSED AND REMANDED.
