PER CURIAM:

¶1 Petitioner Benjamin Paul Romero seeks review of the superior court's order denying his petition for post-conviction relief. This is petitioner's first petition.

¶2 Absent an abuse of discretion or error of law, this court will not disturb a superior court's ruling on a petition for post-conviction relief. *State v.
