ORDER

This 20th day of October 2000, upon consideration of the briefs of the parties, we conclude that the Superior Court's ruling, which resulted in excusal of a juror because of the juror's discomfort with participating in the case due to the juror's knowledge of a State witness, was a discretionary ruling within the authority of the trial judge to manage the trial.
