ORDER

This 12th day of September 2005, upon consideration of the notice to show cause and the defendant's response thereto, it appears to the Court that:

- (1) On July 29, 2005, the Court received the defendant's notice of appeal from a Superior Court Commissioner's order dated July 12, 2005. The Commissioner's order recommended that the Superior Court deny the defendant's motion for postconviction relief.
- (2) Under the Delaware Constitution, this Court may only review a final judgment in a criminal matter.¹ The Commissioner's order is not a final order and

thus is not directly appealable to this Court because the defendant is required first to seek review of the Commissioner's order by a judge of the Superior Court.² Accordingly, this Court is without jurisdiction to review this criminal interlocutory appeal.³

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 29(b), that the within appeal is DISMISSED.
