Neal Gary Rosensweig, counsel for Mario Melo, has filed a motion to

withdraw on appeal supported by a brief prepared pursuant to <u>Anders v.</u>

<u>California</u>, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967). Because our independent review of the entire record reveals no issues of arguable merit, counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED** and Melo's sentence following re-sentencing is **AFFIRMED**.
