Thomas H. Ostrander, appointed counsel for Curtis N	Norris, has filed a

motion to withdraw on appeal, supported by a brief prepared pursuant to <u>Anders v. California</u>, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967). Because independent examination of the entire record reveals no issues of arguable merit, counsel's motion to withdraw is **GRANTED**, and Norris's convictions and sentences are **AFFIRMED**. Norris's motion for an extension of time to file a <u>prose</u> response, and for an order directing counsel to forward the case file and records, is **DENIED AS MOOT**.
