Roland Falcon, appointed counsel for Charles Hudson, Jr., has filed a motion

to withdraw on appeal, supported by a brief prepared pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 87 S.Ct. 1396, 18 L.Ed.2d 493 (1967).
