PER CURIAM:

Brenda K. Monk appeals the district court's order accepting the magistrate judge's recommendation to affirm the Commissioner's decision to deny Monk's claim for continued Supplemental Security Income benefits. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Monk v. Astrue, No. 4:06-cv-00073-JLK (W.D. Va. July 3, 2007).
