PER CURIAM:

Ricky A. Walker appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Walker v. Sec'y of Pub. Safety, No. 1:06-cv-02101-AMD (D. Md. June 22, 2007). We deny Walker's motions for transcript at government expense and for production of documents.
