PER CURIAM:

Nathaniel Burress appeals the district court's orders granting his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006) motion for sentence reduction, and denying his amended § 3582(c)(2) motion. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Burress's motions for appointment of counsel and affirm the district court's orders. <u>United States v.
