PER CURIAM:

Bruce Lee Johnson appeals the district court's order granting his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c) (2006) motion. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. See Dillon v. United States, 2010 WL 2400109 (U.S. June 17, 2010) (No. 09-6338); United States v. Dunphy, 531 F.3d 247, 250-52 (4th Cir. 2009). Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Johnson, No. 4:02-cr-00579-CWH-2 (D.S.C. Feb. 1, 2010).
