PER CURIAM:

Derrick Young appeals the district court's orders dismissing his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2006) complaint without prejudice for failure to exhaust administrative remedies and denying his motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Young v. Waddell, No. 5:10-cv-00101-GCM (W.D.N.C. Aug. 10, 2010 & Nov. 8, 2010). We deny Young's motion for appointment of counsel and his motion to stay the appeal in order to allow him to submit additional documentation.
