PER CURIAM:

Thomas E. Gust appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge dismissing for failure to state a claim his suit against his employer, U.S. Airways and U.S. Payroll/Garnishments Services, for recovery of wages withheld in accordance with a tax lien and damages arising therefrom. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Gust v. U.S. Airways, No. 1:11-cv-00133-MR-DLH (W.D.N.C. Dec. 27, 2011).
