PER CURIAM:

Wimer & Associates, P.C., appeals from the district court's order affirming the bankruptcy court's order dismissing its adversary proceeding filed in Eva Christine Thiel's bankruptcy case seeking a determination that Thiel's debt to it for pre-petition legal fees was not dischargeable in her bankruptcy case. We have reviewed the parties' arguments and the record submitted on appeal and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Wimer & Assocs., P.C. v.
