PER CURIAM:

James Aaron Hayes appeals the district court's orders denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2012) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Hayes' motion for appointment of counsel and affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. Hayes v. Phillips, No. 5:12-ct-03208-D (E.D.N.C. June 10, 2013 & Dec. 15, 2014).
