PER CURIAM:

Tomislav Milic appeals from the district court's order dismissing his appeal from the bankruptcy court's order denying his motion for an expedited hearing on his objection to a sale that was previously approved by the bankruptcy court. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the courts below. *Milic v. McCarthy*, Nos. 1:16-cv-01076-TSE-IDD, 12-16730-BFK (E.D.
