PER CURIAM:

In these consolidated appeals, Joseph Coppola, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order accepting in part the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (2012) petition without prejudice. Coppola also appeals the court's order denying his Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b) motion. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error in either order.
