PER CURIAM:

Edward Kermit Richards, III, appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2012) motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to Amendments 782 and 794 to the <u>U.S. Sentencing Guidelines Manual</u>. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Specifically, both of the Guidelines Amendments under which Richards sought a sentence reduction were in effect at the time of Richards' February 2016 sentencing. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. <u>See United States v. Richards</u>, No. 1:14-cr-00385-CCB-1 (D. Md. Oct. 21, 2016). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
