PER CURIAM:

Christopher Eugene Buckner appeals the district court's order dismissing his complaint against his former employer. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. *See Union Carbide Corp. v. Richards*, 721 F.3d 307, 314-15 (4th Cir. 2013); *Foy v. Giant Food Inc.*, 298 F.3d 284, 287-88 (4th Cir. 2002). Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Buckner v. United Parcel Serv.*, No. 5:16-cv-00644-D (E.D.N.C. Oct. 6, 2016).
