PER CURIAM:

John V. Gough, Jr., appeals the district court's order dismissing his civil action as barred by res judicata. On appeal, we confine our review to the issues raised in the Appellant's brief. *See* 4th Cir. R. 34(b). Because Gough's informal brief does not challenge the basis for the district court's disposition, Gough has forfeited appellate review of the court's order. *See Williams v. Giant Food Inc.*, 370 F.3d 423, 430 n.4 (4th Cir. 2004). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's judgment.
