PER CURIAM:

Richie Leo Williams appeals the district court's order denying his motion to appoint counsel, filed after the court had dismissed Williams' complaint without prejudice for failure to state a claim, as moot. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Williams v. Willis*, No. 1:17-cv-00173-CMH-IDD (E.D.
