PER CURIAM:

Willie Lamark Waters appeals the district court's order denying his motion for a sentence reduction filed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2012) and Amendment 782 to the *U.S. Sentencing Guidelines*. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v. Waters*, No. 2:07-cr-00022-AWA-FBS-1 (E.D. Va. Sept. 22, 2017). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
