PER CURIAM:

Kenya Brown appeals the district court's order granting summary judgment in favor of Akima, LLC, on her claims brought pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17 (West 2012 & Supp. 2019) (Title VII); 42 U.S.C. § 1981 (2012); and the Fairfax County Code, § 1-11-1 *et seq*.
