Rene Ramsey appeals the district court's orders dismissing his complaint filed pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17 (West 2012 & Supp. 2019), for failure to state a claim and denying his motion for reconsideration.
