PER CURIAM:

Thurmond R. Guess, Sr., appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing his civil rights action under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2012) and the district court's order denying Guess' Fed.
