PER CURIAM:

Derrick Allen appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and dismissing Allen's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2018) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B) (2018). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny Allen's motion to appoint counsel and affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Allen v.
