PER CURIAM:

Karen Marie Seay appeals the district court's order dismissing without prejudice Seay's complaint under the Federal Tort Claims Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1346(b)(1), 2671-2680, for failure to comply with Virginia's statutory requirements for bringing a medical malpractice action. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *Seay v. United States*, No. 3:20-cv-00185-DJN (E.D. Va. July 2, 2020).
