PER CURIAM:

Jonathan Allen, a federal prisoner, appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and denying relief on Allen's 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition in which Allen raised a due process challenge to a prison disciplinary proceeding.
