PER CURIAM:

Patrick Jerome Boyd appeals the district court's order denying his motion for compassionate release under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A). After reviewing the record, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying the motion. *See United States v. Chambliss*, 948 F.3d 691, 693 (5th Cir. 2020) (stating standard of review). Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. *United States v.
