PER CURIAM:

Donald Jacobs appeals the district court's order granting Defendant Logistics Management Institute's motion to dismiss Jacobs' claims that he was retaliated against for requesting a disability accommodation and terminated from his employment because of his disability, in violation of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42 U.S.C. §§ 12101 to 12213. We have reviewed the record and the parties' briefs and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *Jacobs v. Logistics Mgmt. Inst.*, No. 1:20-cv-01059-LMB-JFA (Dec. 8, 2020).
