PER CURIAM:

Wardell Jermaine McClam, Jr., appeals the district court's order denying his motion for a sentence reduction under § 404 of the First Step Act of 2018, Pub. L. No. 115-391, 132 Stat. 5194. We have reviewed the record and find no abuse of discretion. *See United States v. Reed*, 58 F.4th 816, 819 (4th Cir. 2023) (providing standard).
