PER CURIAM:

Michael Jermaine McDowell appeals the district court's order denying his second motion for compassionate release under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(1)(A). Upon review of the record, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion by denying McDowell's motion. *See United States v. Malone*, 57 F.4th 167, 172 (4th Cir. 2023) (stating standard of review). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *United States v. McDowell*, No. 5:15-cr-00033-BO-1 (E.D.N.C. Nov. 30, 2023). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before this court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
