PER CURIAM:

Mohamed Mukhtar Iman appeals the district court's order dismissing as untimely his claim pursuant to the Federal Tort Claims Act, 28 U.S.C. §§ 1346(b)(1), 2671-2680 as time-barred. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2401(b).
