Melendez has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief in accordance with *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and *United States v. Flores*, 632 F.3d 229 (5th Cir. 2011). Martinez-Melendez has filed a response. We have reviewed counsel's brief, relevant portions of the record reflected therein, and Martinez-Melendez's response.

We concur with counsel's assessment that the appeal presents no non-frivolous issue for appellate review.
