Appealing the judgment in a criminal case, Jovenal Vasquez-Segura raises an argument that is foreclosed by *United States v. Rodriguez*, 711 F.3d 541, 562 & n.28 (5th Cir. 2013) (en banc), in which we held that the generic, contemporary definition of sexual abuse of a minor does not require the age of

consent to be below 17 years old and does not include an age-differential requirement. Accordingly, the motion for summary affirmance is GRANTED, the alternative motion for an extension of time to file a brief is DENIED, and the judgment of the district court is AFFIRMED.
