ORDER

Upon consideration of DEFENDANT-APPELLANT'S MOTION TO AMEND
OPINION filed by counsel on September 22, 2010,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is GRANTED. The slip opinion issued on September 17, 2010, is amended in two ways. First, the last two sentences of the first paragraph of the opinion are replaced with the following two sentences: "Ellis appealed his conviction and sentence in the Indiana case, and the government appealed the district court's sentencing decision in the Illinois case.
