PER CURIAM.

Missouri state prisoner Wendell Adams appeals the district court's¹ adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. Having carefully reviewed the record in the light most favorable to Adams, *see Moots v. Lombardi*, 453 F.3d 1020, 1022 (8th Cir. 2006) (de novo standard of review), and considered the parties' arguments on appeal, we find no basis for reversal. Accordingly, we affirm. *See* 8th Cir.
