PER CURIAM.

James Kenefick appeals the district court's¹ order dismissing his civil complaint upon a Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6) motion. Upon careful de novo review, <u>see Minn. Majority v. Mansky</u>, 708 F.3d 1051, 1055 (8th Cir.) (standard of review), <u>cert. denied</u>, 134 S. Ct. 824 (2013), we agree with the district court that Kenefick failed to state a facially plausible claim, <u>see Ashcroft v. Iqbal</u>, 556 U.S. 662, 678 (2009). Accordingly, we affirm. <u>See</u> 8th Cir. R. 47B.
