Former federal inmate James H. Phillips appeals the district court's¹ adverse grant of summary judgment in his action under <u>Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics</u>, 403 U.S. 388 (1971), and the Federal Tort Claims Act (FTCA). Phillips has abandoned his FTCA claim, <u>see Hess v. Ables</u>, 714 F.3d 1048, 1051 n.2 (8th Cir. 2013) (abandonment of claim); and we find no basis for overturning the district court's well-reasoned determination that defendants were entitled to summary judgment on his <u>Bivens</u> claims, <u>see Cullor v. Baldwin</u>, 830 F.3d 830, 836 (8th Cir. 2016) (de novo review). The judgment is affirmed. <u>See</u> 8th Cir. R. 47B.
