PER CURIAM.

Travis McKie appeals the sentence the district court¹ imposed after he pleaded guilty to a child pornography offense. His counsel has moved to withdraw and has

filed a brief under <u>Anders v. California</u>, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), challenging the reasonableness of the sentence.

Upon careful review, we conclude that McKie's sentence was not unreasonable, as there is no indication that the district court overlooked a relevant factor, gave significant weight to an improper or irrelevant factor, or committed a clear error of judgment in weighing the relevant factors, see United States v. <u>Feemster</u>, 572 F.3d 455, 461-62 (8th Cir. 2009) (en banc); and the court imposed a sentence below the Guidelines range, see United States v. McCauley, 715 F.3d 1119, 1127 (8th Cir. 2013) (noting that when district court has varied below Guidelines range, it is "nearly inconceivable" that court abused its discretion in not varying downward further).

We have also independently reviewed the record under <u>Penson v. Ohio</u>, 488 U.S. 75 (1988), and we find no non-frivolous issues for appeal. Accordingly, we affirm, and we grant counsel's motions to withdraw.
