MEMORANDUM*

On Petition for Review of an Order of the
Board of Immigration Appeals

Ayman Ali Mohammad, a native and citizen of Jordan, petitions for review of the Board of Immigration Appeals’ (“BIA”) order dismissing his appeal from an immigration judge’s decision denying his adjustment of status application. We dismiss the petition for review.

We lack jurisdiction to consider Mohammad's contentions regarding the denial of his I-130 visa petition as they pertain to the BIA's August 27, 2007, order, and this petition for review is not timely as to that order. *See* 8 U.S.C. § 1252; *Singh v. INS*, 315 F.3d 1186, 1188 (9th Cir. 2003).
