ORDER

The proposed findings and recommendations [Doc. No. 19] submitted by United States Magistrate Judge J. Thomas Ray have been received along with petitioner Michael Feuget's objections and respondent Wendy Kelley's response to Feuget's objections. *See* Doc. Nos. 22, 23. After careful consideration of the record, the proposed findings and recommendations are adopted in their entirety. Accordingly, Feuget's petition for writ of *habeas corpus* [Doc.
