1 By submission of the attorneys of record for Plaintiff Robb Evans, as
2 Receiver over the assets of James P. Lewis, Jr., individually and doing business as
3 Financial Advisory Consultants, Income Fund, Ltd. and Growth Fund, Ltd.,
4 Plaintiff's Application for Entry of Separate Default Judgment Against Defendant
5 Tomijo Stoewsand ("Default Judgment Application") came on regularly for hearing
6 on October 20, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. before the Honorable Audrey B. Collins, United
7 States District Judge presiding in Courtroom 680 of the above-referenced Court.
8 The defendant Tomijo Stoewsand having been regularly served with process, and
9 having failed to appear and answer the Plaintiff's complaint filed herein on January
10 3, 2006, and the default of said defendant having been duly entered and evidence
11 having been considered by the Court, and the Court having reviewed and
12 considered the Default Judgment Application and all pleadings and papers filed in
13 support, including all admissible evidence filed in support thereof, and no opposition
14 to the Default Judgment Application having been filed, and good cause appearing
15 for entry of judgment against the defendant pursuant to Rule 55 of the Federal
16 Rules of Civil Procedure:

17 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that
18 Plaintiff Robb Evans as Receiver of the assets of James P. Lewis, Jr., individually
19 and doing business as Financial Advisory Consultants, Income Fund, Ltd. and
20 Growth Fund, Ltd., shall have judgment against defendant Tomijo Stoewsand
21 ("Stoewsand") in the principal amount of \$62,519.00, together with pre-judgment
22 interest on said sum at the federal statutory rate under 28 U.S.C. § 1961 in effect on
23 the date of filing this lawsuit and through October 21, 2008, in the amount of
24 \$7,624.12 for a total judgment in the amount of \$70,143.12 pursuant to the First,
25 Second and Third Claims for Relief asserted in Plaintiff's Complaint, together with
26 an award of post-judgment interest accruing from and after the date of entry of
27 judgment until paid in full pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1961;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the judgment entered against Stoewsand herein and any other judgments entered heretofore or hereafter in this action against any other defendants are several as to each such defendant unless otherwise expressly stated in the judgment to be joint and several as to the particular defendants;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there is no just reason for delay in entry of this final judgment against Stoewsand, and the Court expressly directs the entry of this separate judgment against Stoewsand pursuant to F.R. Civ. P. 54 notwithstanding whether this action remains pending against other defendants; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall enter this judgment forthwith while this action remains pending against other defendants.
