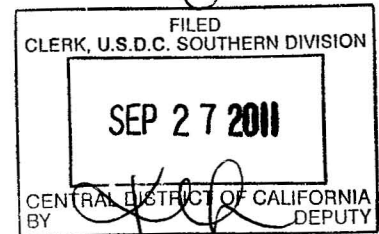

17 Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636, the Court has reviewed the Complaint, records on file,  
18 and the Report and Recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge. Plaintiff has  
19 filed objections to the Report and Recommendation,<sup>1</sup> and the Court has engaged in a de  
20 novo review of those portions of the Report and Recommendation to which her objections  
21 have been made. The Court accepts the findings and recommendations of the Magistrate

Employees." Since the Court's jurisdiction in this action arises under 42 U.S.C. §  
405(g) and is confined to reviewing the Commissioner's denial of benefits, the Court
