5	amend; and

7	(3) Plaintiff is granted leave to file a First Amended Complaint
8	consistent with this Order and the Report.

10	Plaintiff shall have thirty (30) days from the date of this Order
11	within which to file and serve upon counsel for defendants a First
12	Amended Complaint that attempts to cure the defects described in the
13	Report. The First Amended Complaint, if any, shall be complete in
14	itself; it shall not refer in any manner to the original Complaint.
15	
16	Plaintiff is explicitly cautioned that failure to timely file a
17	First Amended Complaint may result in a dismissal of this action for
18	failure to prosecute and/or for failure to comply with this Court's
19	orders, pursuant to Rule 41(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.
