1	B. testing, analyzing, reverse engineering, manipulating, or
2	otherwise extracting codes, data, or information from DISH Network's satellite
3	receivers, smart cards, satellite data stream, or any other part or component of the
4	DISH Network security system.
5	(2) This permanent injunction takes effect immediately.
6	(3) Judgment is entered for DISH Network on Count I of the complaint
7	alleging violations of the Digital Millennium Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. § 1201(a)(1),
8	Count II alleging violations of the Federal Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 605(a),
9	and Count III alleging violations of the Electronic Communications Privacy Act, 18
10	U.S.C. §§ 2511(1)(a) and 2520. The Court is informed that the parties have agreed
11	to a confidential settlement sum, and therefore there are no damages awarded in this
12	judgment.
13	(4) Each party is to bear its own attorney's fees and costs.
14	(5) The Court retains jurisdiction over this action for a period of two years
15	for the purpose of enforcing this final judgment and permanent injunction.
16	PURSUANT TO STIPULATION, IT IS SO ORDERED.
