20 Before this Court is the Stipulation for Judgment under the Perishable
 21 Agricultural Commodities Act of 1930 filed by Plaintiff, Rio Vista Ventures, LLC
 22 and Defendants, Fresh Life Co., Rose Mata a/k/a Jennifer R. Abarca a/k/a Jennifer
 23 Rose, Elvira Mata, and Gabriel Gomez. The Court has reviewed the Stipulation, the
 24 record in this case, applicable law, and is otherwise fully advised. For the reasons
 25 stated below, the Stipulation is GRANTED:

26 **IT IS ORDERED** that Plaintiff's Complaint is amended to change Rose
 27 Mata's name to Rose Mata a/k/a Jennifer R. Abarca a/k/a Jennifer Rose Mata;

28 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that on Count I of Plaintiff's Complaint, the
 Court enters Judgment in favor of Plaintiff, Rio Vista Ventures, LLC and against
 Defendant, Fresh Life Co. in the total Judgment amount of \$29,195.43, plus post-


1 judgment interest at the rate of 18% per year from the date of entry of Judgment until
2 paid in full, for which let execution issue;

3 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that on Count II of Plaintiff’s Complaint, the
4 Court declares that Plaintiff, Rio Vista Ventures, LLC holds a valid claim under the
5 trust provisions of the Perishable Agricultural Commodities Act of 1930, as
6 amended, 7 U.S.C. §499e(c) against Defendant, Fresh Life Co. in the total amount
7 of \$29,195.43, inclusive of attorneys’ fees, costs, and pre-judgment interest;

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that on Count VI of Plaintiff’s Complaint, the
9 Court enters Judgment in favor of Plaintiff, Rio Vista Ventures, LLC and against
10 Defendant, Rose Mata a/k/a Jennifer R. Abarca a/k/a Jennifer Rose Mata, Elvira
11 Mata, and Gabriel Gomez—jointly and severally—in the total Judgment amount of
12 \$29,195.43, plus post-judgment interest at the rate of 18% per year from the date of
13 entry of Judgment until paid in full, for which let execution issue;

14 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Counts III, IV, V, VIII, and IX of
15 Plaintiff’s Complaint are dismissed without prejudice pursuant to FRCP 41.
