22	On September 16, 2009, the Magistrate Judge filed a Findings and Recommendations	
23	herein which was served on plaintiff and which contained notice to the parties that any objection	
24	to the Findings and Recommendations was to be filed within thirty days. Neither party filed a	
25	timely Objection to the Findings and Recommendations.	
26	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a	
27	de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the	
28	Findings and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.

1	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
2	1.	The Findings and Recommendations, filed September 16, 2009, is adopted in full;
3	2.	Defendant Neubarth's motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim, filed August
4		22, 2008, is GRANTED in part with regards to injunctive relief and DENIED in
5		party with regards to qualified immunity;
6	3.	Defendants Ortiz, Bresler, Smith, and Barber's motion to dismiss for failure to
7		exhaust administrative remedies, filed August 22, 2008, is GRANTED in part and
8		DENIED in part as stated in the September 16, 2009 Findings and
9		Recommendations; and
10	4.	Defendants Kushner, Salazar, and Sacks's motion to dismiss for failure to exhaust
11		administrative remedies, filed September 18, 2008, is GRANTED in part and
12		DENIED in part as stated in the September 16, 2009 Findings and
13		Recommendations.
