15	Plaintiff Austin Willis is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil
16	rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate
17	Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.
18 19	On October 23, 2009, the Magistrate Judge screened Plaintiff's Second Amended
20	Complaint and issued Findings and Recommendations recommending dismissal of this action with
20	prejudice for failure to state a claim. After requesting and receiving extensions, Plaintiff submitted
21	timely objections which were filed on May 3, 2010.
22	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this Court has conducted a
23	<u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the Court finds the Findings
25	and Recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper analysis.
26	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
27	1. The Findings and Recommendations, filed October 23, 2009, is adopted in full;
28	2. This action is dismissed with prejudice for Plaintiff's failure to state a claim;
